HOUSING

Housing Unaffordability

Median urban home costs 22 years of median salary in Lisbon, 2041. Rent-to-income ratios in 28 EU cities have broken the social contract. Platform gig work eroded employment stability without replacing safety nets — pushing 34% of knowledge

THE GROVE RESPONSE →

The Grove holds land under a commons trust — no single owner, no landlord, no speculation. Housing is a collective right, not a market.

LEGAL

Administrative Statelessness

The EU Continuous Residency Directive (2038) requires 3 unbroken years of documented national residency for social entitlements. 4.2 million long-term mobile workers are "residentially unverifiable" — with valid passports and no system that recognises

THE GROVE RESPONSE →

The Grove's commons charter creates a portable legal identity. 14 continuous years of Portuguese residency for members. Belonging that the state cannot

HEALTHCARE

6.2M

Platform Healthcare Collapse

Three major nomad health platforms restructured in 18 months (2034–36), leaving 6.2M users' medical records as "data assets." Healthcare designed for residency-based systems fails permanently mobile populations — pre-existing conditions

THE GROVE RESPONSE →

The Grove pairs Dr. Alves (12-year GP relationship) with Mira's herbalism clinic. Technology assists. Continuity of care is built into the community

SOCIAL

61%

The Loneliness Epidemic

61% of adults report clinically significant loneliness (WHO, 2041). The platform collapse of 2035–37 exposed what algorithmic connection could never replace: shared physical space, repeated daily ritual, and intergenerational presence. Nomadic life

THE GROVE RESPONSE →

The Gathering Room at 6:30pm every evening. No agenda, no screens. The most important infrastructure on the land — and the reason The Grove survives

ENVIRONMENTAL

38%

Food & Seed Sovereignty Crisis

38% of EU food crop varieties are at biodiversity risk. Three consecutive El Niño years (2034–37) disrupted global supply chains in ways theoretical resilience planning failed to model. Communities with local food systems, seed libraries, and soil

THE GROVE RESPONSE →

Mira's Seed Library: 420 heritage varieties. 87% food self-sufficient. Soil Intelligence System monitors four field zones. Mira reads the soil with

CARBON

4x

The Carbon Cost of Freedom

Six countries in twelve months = approx. 4x the carbon footprint of a sedentary equivalent lifestyle. The nomadic model is structurally incompatible with 2031 carbon targets. The "laptop on a beach" aesthetic performs environmental consciousness while

THE GROVE RESPONSE →

100% solar energy. Circular food system. Repair culture. Local travel by foot or electric van. The sustainable life is not less — it is differently full.

Mira, age 22, Mumbai — burnout begins. The question forms.

2029

The Grove founded — 10 people, one commons trust, Maria's land

2031

Anti-nomad visa suspensions begin across EU. Risk Gap opens.

2036

NomadHealth collapse — 6.2M records become "data assets"

2038

EU Continuous Residency Directive creates 4.2M "residentially

2041

The Grove: 38 people, 14 households, 87% food-sufficient.
