

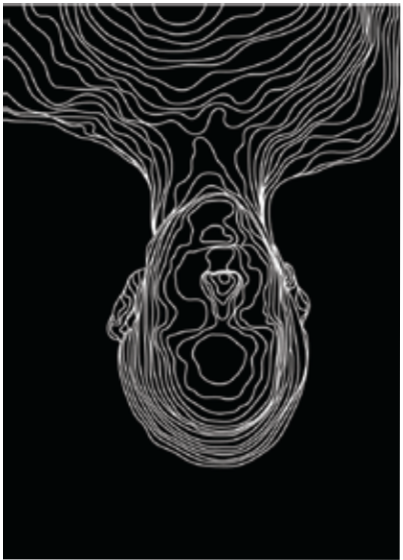
Real power lies in perception

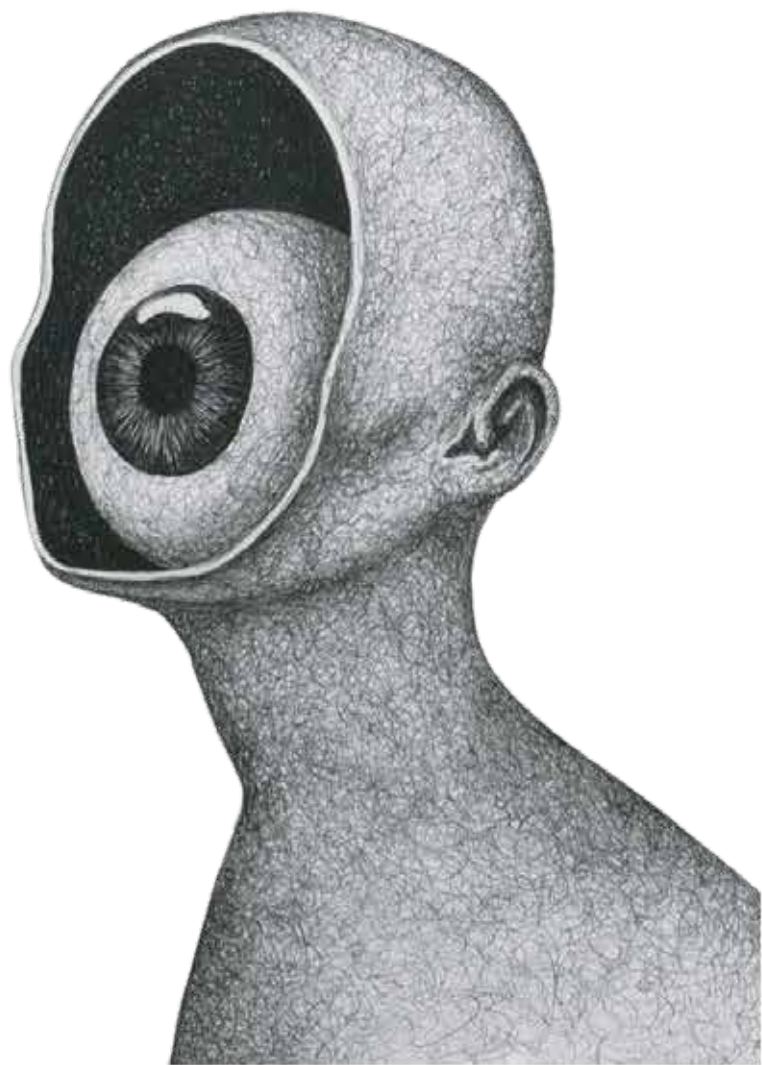
